Earth Class

Reading

You will have your reading book in your book bag.
Can you find the tricky words in your story book?
What do you think happens next in the story? Draw a picture showing this and ask an adult to support you writing a sentence.

Writing

Share the information about England. Practise sounding out graphemes that you know and blend if you can. Draw a picture of your house. Write the numbers on your front door.
Challenge: Write a sentence about your house and where you live.

Maths

Recognising Numbers - Write the numbers from 0 - 10, as your child remembers the numbers in the correct order the next step is to recognise a number to its name. Start with the numbers in sequence and then begin to mix them up. There is an information sheet to support this at home attached to the email.

Challenge: Subtracting a single digit number from 10. E.g. $10-1=9$, $10-2=8$ etc. Use objects to reinforce this. You could use sweets, pieces of chopped fruit or other small food items and when subtracting the number, eat the number of pieces of food.

Construction Challenge - Use some old boxes, packaging and/or other materials. Can you create a famous English landmark like Blackpool Tower or Buckingham Palace?

Take a journey around the world!
Start your journey in England and then either travel on an imaginary boat, train or plane to countries around the world. What do the people enjoy eating there? What animals are in that country?
